I, the undersigned <i>Official Veterinarian</i> , do hereby certify that ⁽²⁾ :	
<p>A the above-listed products are being exported from a country or zone specified at Appendix VI of Decree No. 06-XX/GNC and that they meet any restrictive requirements which may be set forth in Column 4 of Appendix VI of Decree No. 06-XX/GNC ;</p> <p>B the above-listed products or their constituents or raw materials:</p> <p>1) have undergone the <i>ad hoc</i> treatments specified at Appendix I of Decree No. 06-XX/GNC for inactivating the pathogens of Newcastle disease (ND) and notifiable avian influenza (NAI);</p> <p>or 2) meet the requirements C and D;</p> <p>C the above-listed products or their constituents or raw materials (when they do contain <i>fresh meat</i> or <i>meat products of poultry</i>) are entirely derived from animals which have passed <i>ante-mortem</i> and <i>post-mortem</i> inspections especially for Newcastle disease and notifiable avian influenza;</p> <p>D the above-listed products or their constituents or raw materials:</p> <p>1) are entirely derived from animals that, from hatching or not less than 3 months up to and including slaughter or eggs collection, have stayed in and travelled through only zones:</p> <p>a) specified in Appendix VI of Decree No. 06-XX/GNC;</p> <p>and b) that were not subject to any bans (at the time the animals were staying in or travelling through such countries or zones) as specified at Appendix VI Column 3 of Decree No. 06-XX/GNC;</p> <p>and c) that were (at the time the animals were staying in or travelling through such countries or zones) ND-free and highly pathogenic notifiable avian influenza (HPNAI)-free;</p> <p>and d) in which there has been no evidence of Newcastle disease or highly pathogenic notifiable avian influenza:</p> <p>i) up until this certificate was issued;</p> <p>or ii) within three months after the animals stayed in or travelled through or were slaughtered in such countries or zones;</p> <p>or iii) within three months after the eggs were collected in such countries or zones;</p> <p>and 2) are entirely derived from animals that, from hatching or not less than 3 months up to and including slaughter or eggs collection, have stayed in and travelled through only establishments:</p> <p>a) that were (at the time the animals were staying in or travelling through such establishments) NAI-free;</p> <p>and b) in which there has been no evidence of notifiable avian influenza:</p> <p>i) up until this certificate was issued;</p> <p>or ii) within three months after the animals stayed in or travelled through such establishments;</p> <p>or iii) within three months after the eggs were collected in such establishments;</p> <p>and 3) are entirely derived from animals that, from hatching or no fewer than 30 days prior to and including slaughter or egg collection, have always remained at a distance of not less than 10 km away from any case of Newcastle disease or notifiable avian influenza;</p>
