Forest Service Prepares for Prescribed Burning In Tamphrey Creek Drainage

Wednesday September 28, 2005 the Bozeman Ranger District will be implementing a prescribed burn in a 20 acre area in the Tamphery Creek drainage in the Gallatin Mountain Range, off of highway 191. The burn is approximately 23 miles south of Bozeman, Montana and 15 mi. north east of Big Sky, Montana. District fire management personnel have been preparing the area in anticipation of favorable weather conditions for prescribed burning.
