West Yellowstone, MT - The public is invited to a free showing of the "Greatest Good" on Saturday, May 14, from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m., at the Earthquake Lake Visitor Center, located 27 miles northwest of West Yellowstone along highway 287.

"The Greatest Good" is a two-hour documentary produced for the Centennial of the U.S. Forest Service. The film uses rarely seen footage and photos, sweeping high-definition landscape aerial shots, and dozens of interviews to tell a complex and compelling story of the American land. Narrated by Charles Osgood, this documentary brings the history of the Forest Service to a broad audience.
