Natural Bridge Recreation Site and Main Boulder Ranger Station & Visitors Center Reconstruction and Interpretive Signing

Big Timber, MT... The Big Timber Ranger District has started trail reconstruction and parking area and interpretive sign improvement at the Natural Bridge Recreation Site and the Main Boulder Ranger Station and Visitors Center. The project will improve the trail system to aid access for disabled visitors, improve the grade and location of trails around the site, add new railings and interpretive signing at overlooks, and pave portions of the parking lot and trails.

At the historic Main Boulder Ranger Station, work has begun to pave parking areas and walkways and add new interpretive panels to the site.

Both sites will be accessible to visitors; however people should expect ongoing reconstruction efforts and be aware of the workers in these areas. No recreation use changes are being proposed at either site. All reconstruction and improvement activities are expected to be complete the summer of 2006.
