Interagency Passes Available at Hebgen Lake Ranger District

West Yellowstone, MT... If you are traveling to federal recreation lands this spring you may want to consider purchasing an Interagency Annual Pass. These passes, also known as America the Beautiful National Parks and Federal Recreational Passes are available at the Hebgen Lake Ranger District.

The Interagency Annual pass can be purchased for \$80.00 and is valid 12 months from the month of purchase. "If you purchase a pass, it will provide access nationwide at all Forest Service, National Park Service, Bureau of Land Management, and U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service sites that charge an entrance or standard amenity fee," said Joanne Girvin, Hebgen Lake Visitor Information Assistant. "If you are doing a lot of traveling it may be cost effective to purchase a pass rather than paying the individual fees."

The Interagency Senior pass is a lifetime pass for U.S. citizens age 62 or older. Pass price is \$10.00. The Senior pass also provides access nationwide and provides a 50% discount at some campgrounds.
