Travel Planning Area Direction Under Alternative 1

Alternative 1 is the "no action" alternative. There would be no changes to current management direction applicable to travel management.

Travel Planning Area Direction Under Alternatives 2 through 7-M

- GOAL 1: Summer Recreation Use. Provide opportunities for summer recreation use that include hiking, mountain biking, ATV and motorcycle use. *This goal applies to Alternatives 2 through 7-M, except that opportunities for ATV use would be dropped in Alternative 5 and Alternative 7-M within the Cabin Creek R&WMA, and all motorized use would be dropped in Alternative 6.*
 - **OBJ. 1-1a:** Manage the road and trail system to provide for the following types of summer recreation use. *This objective applies to Alternatives 2 through 6, however, the amount of opportunity varies as shown in the table below. The column for Alternative 7-M is provided for information only.*

- GOAL 2: Winter Recreation Use. Provide opportunities for winter recreation use emphasizing snowmobile use. This goal applies to Alternatives 2 through 5, and 7-M. There would be no winter recreation opportunity goal under Alternative 6.
- **OBJ. 2-1a:** Manage the road and trail system to provide for the following types of winter recreation use. *This objective applies to Alternatives 2 through 5, however, the amount of opportunity varies as shown in the table below. The column for Alternative 7-M is provided for information only.*



Any future proposals to change the uses specified should be done in consideration of the targeted recreation setting to be provided [see the "Recreation Opportunity Spectrum" (ROS) map for winter uses under Alternative 7-M] which is hereby incorporated by reference. *This objective applies to Alternative 7-M only.*
- **GOAL 3:** Grizzly Bear and Wildlife Habitat. Manage motorized travel, both summer and winter, to maintain quality habitat for wildlife and provide for grizzly bear and big game security. *This goal applies to Alternatives 2 through 6.*
 - **OBJ. 3-1:** Effectively close undesignated trails to motorized summer use. *This objective applies to Alternatives 2 through 6.*
 - **OBJ. 3-2:** Eliminate the potential that grizzly bears would be disturbed by snowmobiles upon den emergence. *This objective applies to Alternatives 2 through 6.*
- **GOAL 4: Fisheries.** Provide habitat for westslope cutthroat trout in the Middle Fork of Cabin Creek. *This goal applies to Alternatives 2 through 7-M.*

In this Travel Planning Area, this goal is pursued through application of Forest-wide standards.
