A. Alternative Travel Area Goals, Objectives, Standards and Guidelines

Travel Planning Area Direction Under Alternative 1

Alternative 1 is the "no action" alternative. There would be no changes to current management direction applicable to travel management.

Travel Planning Area Direction Under Alternatives 2 through 7-M

- **GOAL 1:** Summer Recreation Use. Provide opportunities for both motorized and non-motorized summer recreation use with emphasis on motorcycle, ATV, horse and pack stock use. In addition, provide moderate levels of opportunity for mountain biking, pleasure driving and 4 x 4 use on backcountry roads. *This goal applies to Alternatives 2 through 5, and 7-M. In Alternative 6, motorcycle and ATV use would not be emphasized.*
 - **OBJ. 1-1a:** Manage the road and trail system to provide for the following types of summer recreation use. *This objective applies to Alternatives 2 through 6, however, the amount of opportunity varies as shown in the table below. The column for Alternative 7-M is provided for information only.*


