

2002 Water Sources Attendance by Region



The 2004 Water Sources

Cancellation Policy

Booth cancellations must be received by AWWA in writing. Refunds are issued as follows:

Prior to the assignment date of October 8, 2003	Full refund of monies paid.
After October 8, 2003, but prior to November 28, 2003	The 25% deposit will be forfeited to AWWA.
After November 28, 2003	No refund will be made. Unoccupied space may be reassigned by AWWA.




