Note: Pursuant to Section 436B-14.5, HRS, any license held by a member of the armed forces, National Guard, or a reserve component that expires, is forfeited, or deemed delinquent while the member is on active duty and deployed during a state or national crisis shall be restored if certain restoration requirements are met. This shall also apply to a member, whose license is current, but will expire within 120 DAYS of the member's discharge or release from active duty deployment. THIS SHALL NOT APPLY TO a member who is on a scheduled annual or specialized training or to any person whose license is suspended or revoked, or who is subject to disciplinary action on a license. Restoration requests must be submitted within 120 DAYS after being discharged or released from active duty deployment.
