Dear Dr. Lederberg:


I am forwarding to you, under separate cover, nine mouse strains of E. coli. One of these strains has been made streptomycin resistant in vitro, and I send it along in case you can use it. (These two tubes are labeled coli S and coli R.)

The strains include both pre and post radiation isolations from feces and one or two from hearts' blood cultures. I have not indicated any of these characteristics, but if you want this information, we will be happy to label them in the future.

I hope your experiments on our mouse strains prove to be profitable.
