
Dear Dr. Lederberg:

A shipment of 20 mouse strains of E. coli is being sent to you today. They include both heart's blood (HB) and feces cultures, all of which were isolated at autopsy after radiation.

Numbers 5 & 6 and 18 & 19 are the HB and feces cultures from the same mouse. Five strains were isolated from animals which had been fed streptomycin (1 and 10 units/cc) in their drinking water.

I enclose a protocol identifying each culture as to its source, the dose of radiation and the amount of drug fed to the animal.
