
REVISED VS CURRENT 241.1/HARVESTING DATA FIELDS

CHANGE

- Copyrighted Material (Restrictions Y or N) to Copyrighted Material with Restrictions - Copyrighted Material without restrictions should be marked unclassified
- Official Use Only to elaborate Security Sensitive Information/Circumvention of Statute ("High 2")
- Proprietary/Trade Secret to Limited Rights Data on Pages_____ this reflects current terminology






Distribution Limitation Markings Guide Usage

- Tool for anyone who interprets markings on documents from DOE, DoD, and NASA for purposes of providing secondary distribution
- Markings of CENDI agencies are similar, but not exactly the same





The Format of the Guide

- Part I alphabetical listing of all markings, acronyms & abbreviations
- Part II markings are organized by agency
- Part III markings are organized by general categories
- Appendix I non-Intelligence, but obsolete or superseded markings
- Annex Intelligence markings (OUO)
