Digitized Legacy Collections

OSTI Exchange with DOE Facilities

If your facility has any of its pre-1995 STI collection digitized, OSTI would be interested in copies of the collection, or URLs to the collection. If you are planning to digitize your collection, OSTI can give you electronic copies of your bibliographic records from the Energy Citations Database (<http://www.osti.gov/energycitation>) in XML format. OSTI's Legacy Scanning Project

OSTI is planning to scan its legacy collection, starting with Manhattan Project documents. Some of these documents do not have sensitivity markings. OSTI will be loading the scanned document, bibliographic information and at least preliminary sensitivity information in E-Link, including the site of origination. OSTI will notify the sites when documents are loaded in E-Link where the sensitivity assessment is not certain, and would like the sites to review those, correct the access limitation if necessary and release the E-Link records.

CENDI Survey

CENDI, the interagency working group of senior Scientific and Technical Information Managers from nine U.S. Federal Agencies, is conducting a survey on permanent access to STI digital information originally published electronically.
