Classified/Declassified STI Issues and Activities

Background

- OSTI has been central repository for DOE and predecessor agencies since 1947 for classified and limited agency-funded research and development documents.
- Formalized in 1986 in DOE 1430.3,
 Policy for the Dissemination of and Access to Dept. Unclassified STI

Current STI Policy

- DOE O 241.1 & DOE G 241.1-1 include classified, declassified, and limited
- Requirements: DOE programs shall ensure that STI is reviewed for sensitivity (including non-proliferation, national security, export control); and that appropriate announcement and availability restrictions are applied consistent with statutory and/or other Departmental requirements.
- All DOE elements shall make STI broadly available in useful and acceptable forms, including announcing such STI results to the central coordinating office.
- CRD: Make useful STI available to OSTI ... whether unclassified, sensitive, or classified.

OSTI Products/Services

- Controlled Access File: unclassified, controlled STI
- Classified Energy Online (CLEO): announcement of classified STI and approved database access.
- Documents for approved recipients.
- Interagency exchange DOD and DTIC.
- Special services/products for HQ Programs (e.g., OpenNet and Applied Technology).
- Reengineering under way; secure, online full-text information is a primary goal.
