2007 I/T/U Colposcopy Update and Review

This two and a half day program will bring together a superb faculty of nationally known experts in colposcopy and lower genital tract disease to provide a review and update of colposcopy, vulvar and vaginal disease, and human papilloma-virus. New developments will be extensively covered including the HPV Vaccine, use of HPV, DNA testing, and the 2006 ASCCP Consensus Conference.

Who should attend?

The program is targeted for IHS, Tribal, and Urban Indian clinic providers, but all colposcopists are welcome. It's ideal for gynecologists and primary care providers who do colposcopy. If colposcopy and the management of abnormal Pap tests is a part of your practice, this course is for you. It's an ideal review for experienced colposcopists as well as novices still in their preceptorship and for those preparing for the ASCCP Mentorship Exam.

The format includes:

- * Small group slide review sessions

At the conclusion of this course, attendees will be better able to...

- ◆ Identify cervical lesions including CIN and invasive cancer.
- ◆ Discuss the limitations of colposcopy.
- ◆ Use newly revised evidence-based national guidelines to manage women with abnormal cervical cytology results.
- ◆ More effectively evaluate and manage VIN and VAIN.
- ◆ Recognize and manage benign vulvar dermatoses.
- ◆ Use HPV DNA testing in clinical practice.
- ◆ Discuss the indications for and benefits of the HPV Vaccine.

ASCCP Test

At the course conclusion on April 18, a Colposcopy Mentorship Program Exam sponsored by the ASCCP will be offered. The exam costs \$125.00.
