

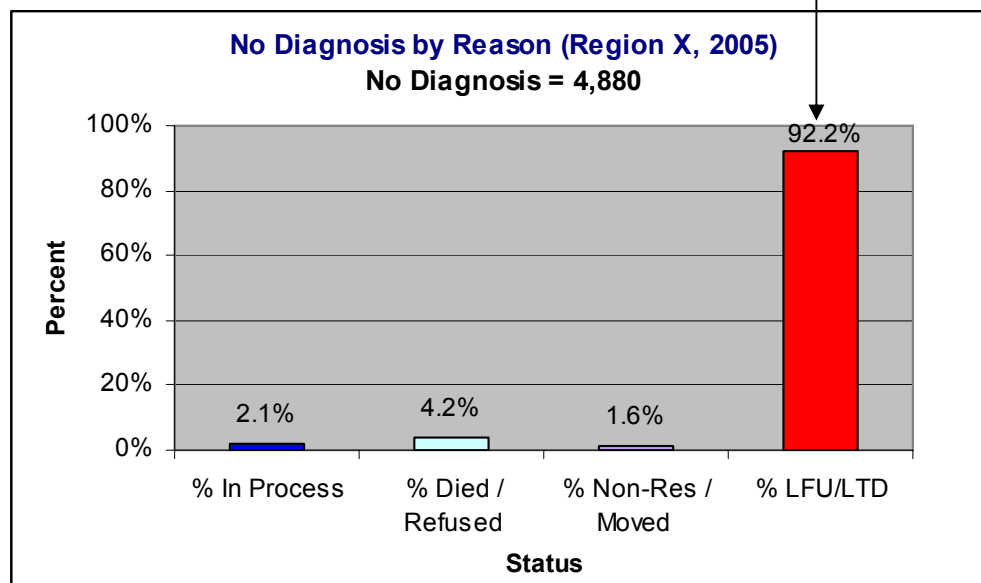
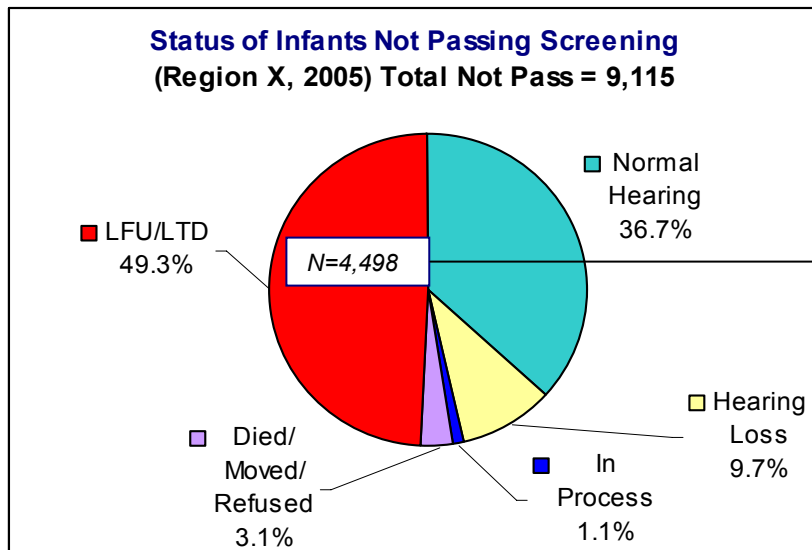
Summary of CDC-EHDI Survey Data by Region: Calendar Year 2005

Region X States

- AK, AZ, CA, HI, NV, American Samoa*, Federation of Micronesia*, Guam, Marshall Islands*, N. Mariana Islands, Palau*

Summary of Key Data Indicators

- **Occurrent Births:** 672,747
- **Percent Not Passing (final screen):** 1.7% (9,115 infants)
- **Normal Hearing:** 3,347
- **Percent Screened:** 79.0% (531,639 infants)
- **No Diagnosis:** 4,880 (53.5%)
- **Hearing Loss / Incidence:** 888 / 1.7 per 1,000 screened



- **No Diagnosis:** Includes infants that are “In process,” “Died / Parents declined services,” “Non-residents or Moved out of jurisdiction,” and “Unable to contact / Unresponsive / Unknown”
- **LFU / LTD:** Loss to Follow-up / Loss to Documentation
 - Represents cases with no diagnosis due to reasons including “Unable to contact” or “Unresponsive” family and “Unknown” status
