BLM OFFERS \$500 REWARD FOR INFORMATION

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

DILLON (March 10, 2006) – The Bureau of Land Management’s Dillon Field Office is offering a \$500 reward for information leading to the conviction of the person or persons responsible for vandalism of two picnic tables at the Deadwood Gulch Campground just off the Big Sheep Creek Road southwest of Dell.

The incident was believed to have occurred during late February or early March. A vehicle was used to hook on to the picnic tables and drag them until the legs broke and the frames were destroyed.

“All people who enjoy recreating on public lands pay the price when recreational facilities are deliberately destroyed,” commented Rick Waldrup, Recreation Planner for the Dillon Field Office.
