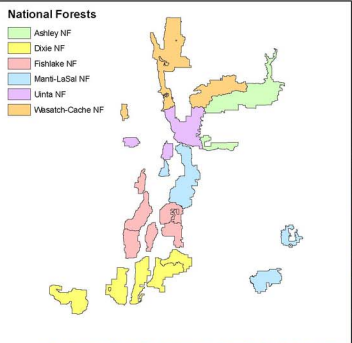


Wild & Scenic Rivers Suitability Study for National Forest System Lands in Utah
