PLEASE STAY ON DESIGNATED ROADS AND TRAILS



Cross-country travel is authorized in areas designated on the forest travel map. However, cross-country travel can lead to:

- Damage to vegetation.
- Increased user traffic.
- Erosion.
- Threatened watersheds.
- Wildlife disturbances.
- Safety issues for users.

The Forest Service and its partners have invested many years and thousands of dollars to develop safe, defined motorized travel routes.

Staying on existing open roads and trails:

- Provides for a variety of recreational experiences.
- Allows the area's natural vegetation to recover more quickly.
- Minimizes soil erosion.
- Protects the area's natural water supply.
- Provides for the needs of both wildlife and hunters.
- Reduces costs of maintaining roads and trails.

Help ensure that motorized travel remains possible on these public lands in the future – stay on designated existing roads and trails.
