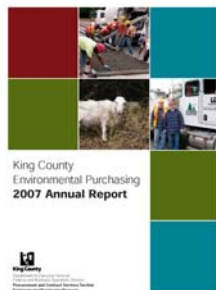

### Introduction

The 2007 King County Environmental Purchasing Annual Report, which details **41 million dollars** worth of environmentally preferable products purchased by County agencies in the past year, is now available. These purchases include items such as recycled paper, toner cartridges, re-refined oil, biodiesel, and hybrid cars. In addition to increasing King County's level of support of markets for these materials, these purchases also brought **\$877,000** in **savings** to County agencies.

We would like to thank all of the King County agencies that contribute to this effort year after year.
