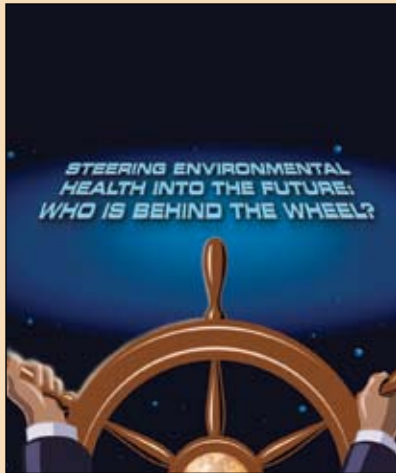


# Environmental Health
