#### **Bank Fees**

When our checking account balance drops below \$400.00 we pay a monthly fee of \$4.00. Bay Winds waived that fee for August, but we will have it for September. Balance is \$360.25.

The Jordan River NFH will donate \$50.00 to keep the checking account balance above \$400.00.

#### Fish R Fun

Tim Smigielski requested assistance from the FOH for staffing, snacks and topic ideas for the three Fish R Fun programs. The dates are January 23, February 27 and March 27. The following ideas were discussed: fish habitat enhancement/fish passage projects; tie dye fish t-shirt; fly fishing/fly tying; fish techniques and safe snowmobiling presentation in conjunction with the East Jordan Snowmobiling Club. The January 23 topic will be "Ice Fishing Nite" with potential help from Dan Myers presenting ice fishing for crappie and blue gills.

#### Logo

### **Future Projects**

The hatchery discussed several projects that the FOH could help with. They included Fish R Fun, Traverse City Expo, T-21 road upgrades, Cheboygan River Front projects (home port for the Baird), procure raffle items for kids events, Charge the Hill (FWS goes to Washington DC to brief congressionals on our accomplishments and future projects) February 26-March 2, 2007, implementing the new Volunteer Act for hatcheries, and grant writing. Clarice Beckner just attended training on writing grants, so we could use her expertise.

The group discussed potential volunteer projects that FOH members could participate in, which include spawning broodstock at Pendills Creek or Iron River NFH (September – October), putting eggs away at Jordan River NFH (November – January), going on fish distribution runs (April – June) and riding the M/V Baird (April – November).
