

Friends of the Jordan River National Fish Hatchery Stewardship Project



In April 2006, the FJRNFH adopted a 2.5 mile section of the North Country National Scenic Trail located across the river from the Hatchery. The FJRNFH now provides maintenance of the trail section in agreement with the North Country Trail Association.

Yearly maintenance begins with a Spring Walk Through on Earth Day. This involves clearing the trail of downed trees, branches and litter. East Jordan Cub Scout Pack 17 joined us for the event this year and helped us out tremendously!

June brings on the need for trimming, as new growth begins to overcrowd the trail. Trail trimming is a sweaty, buggy job but somebody has to do it! ☺



Throughout summer and fall hikers are needed to enjoy the trail and remove any newly fallen branches and litter along the way.

Trail maintenance, other than the Spring Walk Through, can be done individually, by families or by small groups. Interested persons may sign up to help out....as sawyers, trimmers or as general trail crew.
