### **CURRENT RESERVOIR CONDITIONS:**

Elevation: 3776.97; Storage: 1,274,943 acre-feet; River Release: 4,960 cfs; Inflow: 6,700 cfs;

### **GENERAL COMMENTS:**

To control the rate of rise in the lake and to assist construction crews at Goose and Broadwater Bays, the following operation change is required at Canyon Ferry Dam and Powerplant.

### **CANYON FERRY RELEASES AND OPERATIONS:** All times are Mountain Daylight Savings Time (MDST)

#### **At 0100 hour on Thursday, April 13, 2006:**

*Maintain releases through the river outlet gates at 0 cfs.*

*Maintain releases through the spillway gates at 0 cfs.*

*Increase turbine releases to 5,540 cfs ( $\approx$  1251 MW-Hrs/day using 106.3 cfs/mw).*

*Maintain releases for Helena Valley Project at 260 cfs (100 cfs pumped to Helena Valley and 160 cfs discharged to the Missouri River).*

*Increase average daily release to the Missouri River to about 5,700 cfs.*

*Increase average total release from Canyon Ferry to about 5,800 cfs.*
