CURRENT RESERVOIR CONDITIONS:

Elevation: 3785.00; Storage: 1,506,757 acre-feet; River Release: 3,950 cfs; Inflow: 2,095 cfs;

GENERAL COMMENTS:

Based on the January water supply forecast and continue conserving storage as previously scheduled, turbine releases from Canyon Ferry will be reduced as follows.

CANYON FERRY RELEASES AND OPERATIONS: All times are Mountain Standard Time (MST)

At 0100 hour on Friday, January 19, 2007:

Maintain releases through the river outlet gates at 0 cfs.

Maintain releases through the spillway gates at 0 cfs.

Decrease turbine releases to 3,450 cfs (\approx 817 MW-Hrs/day using 101.3 cfs/mw).

Maintain release for Helena Valley Project at 0 cfs.

Decrease average total release from Canyon Ferry to about 3,450 cfs.
