### **CURRENT RESERVOIR CONDITIONS:**

Elevation: 3784.68; Storage: 1,496,968 acre-feet; River Release: 3,475 cfs; Inflow: 3,170 cfs;

### **GENERAL COMMENTS:**

Triennial maintenance is scheduled for Unit No. 3 of the Canyon Ferry Powerplant. In response, the following operation change is required at Canyon Ferry Dam and Powerplant, restricting and limiting turbine releases to 2-unit capacity during the triennial maintenance.

### **CANYON FERRY RELEASES AND OPERATIONS:** All times are Mountain Standard Time (MST)

**At 0800 hour on Tuesday, February 20, 2007 through 1700 hour on Thursday, March 15, 2007:**

*Maintain releases through the river outlet gates at 0 cfs.*

*Maintain releases through the spillway gates at 0 cfs.*

*Maintain turbine releases at 3,450 cfs ( $\approx$  817 MW-Hrs/day using 101.3 cfs/mw).*

*Maintain release for Helena Valley Project at 0 cfs.*

*Maintain average daily release to the Missouri River at about 3,450 cfs.*

*Maintain average total release from Canyon Ferry at about 3,450 cfs.*
