

Marion Pressure Treating Site Marion, Union Parish, Louisiana

The abandoned wood treating facility was proposed to the EPA National Priorities List in 1999.

EPA conducted a remedial investigation and feasibility study in 2000. It was uncovered that soils and sediments in some areas contain creosote and chemicals at concentrations that can present an unacceptable risk to human health and the environment.



To address immediate risks, the site was fenced and new gates were installed.

A Proposed Plan with permanent solutions was presented to the public in 2001. During 2002 the EPA will make a final decision on the best permanent remedy for this site.
