## First Federal Facility “Ready for Reuse” Certificate Announced

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) will issue a “ready for reuse” certificate to the U.S. Air Force for Brooks City-Base (formerly Brooks Air Force Base) in San Antonio, Texas. The certificate is the first of its kind to be issued in Texas, and the first for a federal facility nationally. The “ready for reuse” certificate verifies that environmental conditions on this property are protective of its current use and anticipated future use as a technology and business park.
