McGregor Property to be Declared "Ready for Reuse"

(Dallas, Texas – October 26, 2006) The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Texas

Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) will issue a "ready for reuse" determination to the U.S. Navy

and the City of McGregor, Texas. The "ready for reuse" determination verifies that environmental conditions

at the former Naval Weapons Industrial Reserve Plant in McGregor are protective of human health and the

environment for its current and anticipated commercial, industrial and agricultural uses. This determination

is the first awarded to a U.S. Navy facility nationally.
