

ACMUI Meeting Summary
March 1-2, 2004

The Advisory Committee on the Medical Uses of Isotopes (ACMUI) met on March 1-2, 2004. March 1 consisted of a public meeting from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. From 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., March 1, the ACMUI held a closed session meeting to receive a safeguards briefing and to discuss ethical and other administrative issues. On March 2, the ACMUI briefed the Commission, then resumed its public meeting.

The topics of discussion during the public meeting were varied, and they ranged from discussion on the optimal time to remove an emerging modality out of 10 CFR Part 35.1000, to how best to define medical events involving prostate seed implants. ACMUI also discussed the status report of a dose reconstruction review. ACMUI's follow up action includes holding a public teleconference on March 22, 2004, to discuss training and experience issues associated with 10 CFR Part 35.

During the March 1-2, 2004, meeting, the ACMUI made several recommendations. Staff will review these recommendations and forward its response in approximately 30 days after the meeting.
