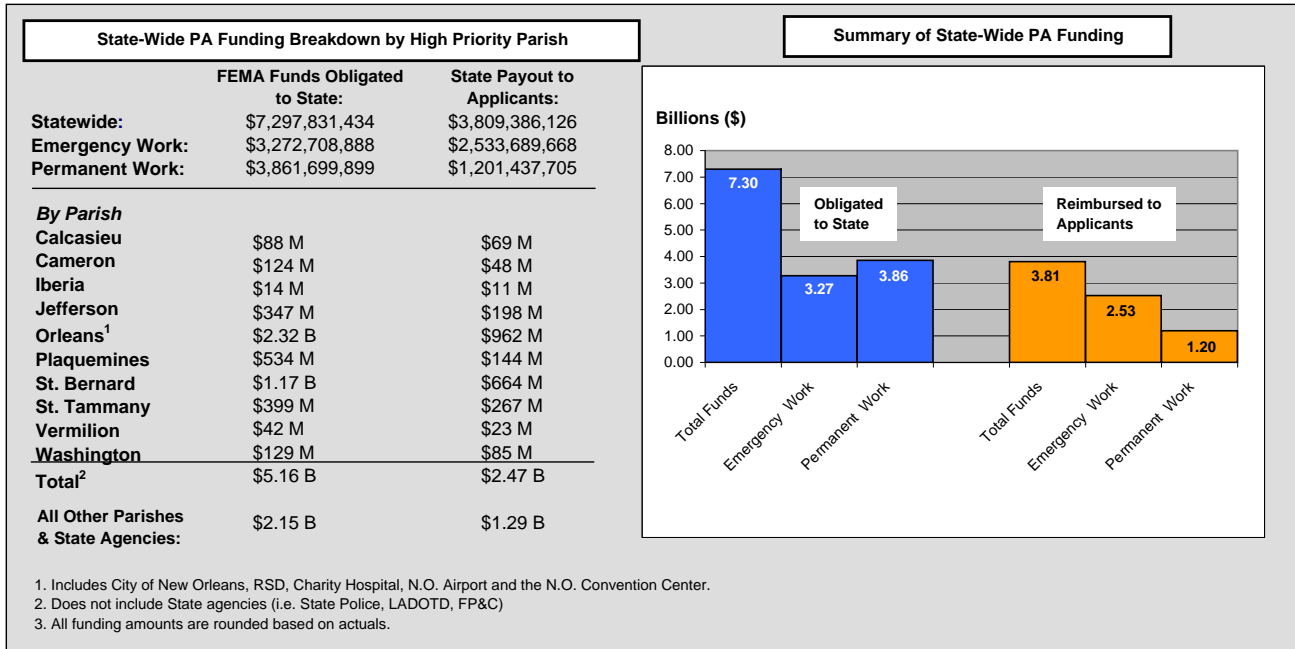




FEMA Public Assistance for Louisiana Recovery

Continued Support of Louisiana Recovery FEMA Public Assistance Weekly Update

- Over \$47K in Public Assistance funding was obligated to East Jefferson General Hospital for the repair of a DYCO Screening Van and the purchase of a new ambulance.
- Over \$182K in Public Assistance funding was obligated to the Office of Public Health, Louisiana Department of Health Hospitals for reimbursement of evacuation costs, labor and supplies; in addition to sheltering costs for both Ochsner Clinic and the Lindy Boggs Medical Center.
- Over \$25K in Public Assistance funding was obligated to the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries for Grand Terre Marine Laboratory to be combined with over \$47K (which was allocated for the replacement of boat, motor and trailer assembles for 3 boats) to purchase a new boat assemble.
- Nearly \$73K in Public Assistance funding was obligated to Plaquemines Parish for the reimbursement of costs of repairs to catch basins.
