## **Congressman Doyle Collects On Steelers-Broncos Bet**

Washington, DC – February 1, 2006 – U.S. Representative Mike Doyle (PA-14) today enjoyed a hearty lunch of Denver tamales and Fat Tire beer – courtesy of U.S. Representative Diane DeGette (CO-7).

"Corn meal wrapped in corn husks never tasted so good," Congressman Doyle said after sampling some of Denver's finest food. "I guess that's because in this case, it tastes like a great Steelers victory."

Representatives Doyle and DeGette had agreed that the loser of the Steelers-Broncos game would buy the winner and their staff lunch. Representative DeGette represents Denver in the House of Representatives, while Congressman Doyle represents Pittsburgh.

The Steelers beat the Broncos handily by a score of 34 to 17 on January 22<sup>nd</sup>, winning a ticket to the Super Bowl, where they will play the Seattle Seahawks on February 5<sup>th</sup>.
