Provide a general picture of resource concerns for a broad area, an estimate of the conservation needs, and an estimate of funding needs as well as potential sources of funding.






Recent Steps

- Rapid watershed assessment methodology and guidance was developed and posted on website
- In FY 2006, funded \$3 million through the Cooperative Conservation Partnership Initiative for developing rapid watershed assessments (8-digit HUCs).
- In FY 2007, funded \$2 million through the CCPI for developing rapid watershed assessments (8-, 10-, & 12-digit HUCs).
