Building on Rapid Watershed Assessments

Developing Area wide or Watershed Plans

At this point, the rapid watershed assessment will have addressed the first six steps of the NRCS planning process on a broad scale. The information is general in nature and is not sufficiently detailed to be used as a plan. However, the information should be a solid starting point for local stakeholders to use should they decide to proceed with a more detailed area wide or watershed planning effort. Guidance for these planning efforts can be found in the NRCS National Planning Procedures Handbook, the Basin and Area Planning Manual, or the National Watershed Manual.
