

4,676 farms in 2002, 4,485 farms in 1997, up 4 percent.

215,210 acres in 2002, 195,602 acres in 1997, up 10 percent.

46 acres in 2002, 44 acres in 1997, up 5 percent.

#### **Market Value of Production**

\$332,005,000 in 2002, \$283,929,000 in 1997, up 17 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$273,316,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$58,689,000 of the total value in 2002.

#### Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$71,002 in 2002, \$63,306 in 1997, up 12 percent.


#### **Government Payments**
