

2,020 acres in 2002, 2,105 acres in 1997, down 4 percent.

#### **Market Value of Production**

\$43,223,000 in 2002, \$57,261,000 in 1997, down 25 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$33,685,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$9,538,000 of the total value in 2002.

#### Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$80,340 in 2002, \$105,647 in 1997, down 24 percent.


#### **Government Payments**
