

\$12,050,000 in 2002, \$13,348,000 in 1997, down 10 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$6,493,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$5,557,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$15,370 in 2002, \$18,260 in 1997, down 16 percent.


Government Payments
