

Market Value of Production

\$10,257,000 in 2002, \$11,595,000 in 1997, down 12 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$813,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$9,443,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$7,487 in 2002, \$8,633 in 1997, down 13 percent.


Government Payments
