

\$123,180,000 in 2002, \$103,701,000 in 1997, up 19 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$86,332,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$36,848,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$81,684 in 2002, \$63,155 in 1997, up 29 percent.


Government Payments
