

\$295,070,000 in 2002, \$295,683,000 in 1997, down slightly. Crop sales accounted for \$47,445,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$247,624,000 of the total value in 2002.

#### Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$916,366 in 2002, \$929,820 in 1997, down 1 percent.


## **Government Payments**
