EFFECTIVE DATE:

April 1, 2008. This revised fee schedule supersedes all other fee schedules issued by this agency. The Federal Grain Inspection Service (FGIS) must approve all fees for official services and OAs will assess only those fees appearing on their current approved fee schedule.

INSPECTION POINTS:

Opelousas, Jonesville, Oak Grove (LOUISIANA)

REGULAR HOURS:

8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday except holidays. Holidays and all other hours will be considered overtime.

HOURLY RATES:

Regular hours are \$26.00 per hour. Overtime hours are \$39.00 per hour (assessed in half-hour increments)

HOLIDAYS:

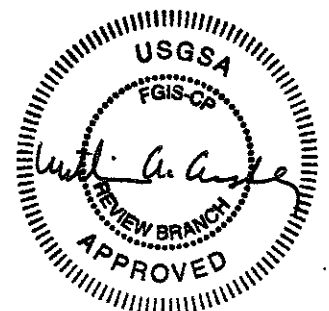
New Years, Mardi Gras, Good Friday, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veterans' Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, Election Day (every 2 years), and any other day the Governor proclaims as a legal holiday

MILEAGE AND TRAVEL RATE

The IRS standard mileage rate and applicable hourly rate for actual miles traveled from nearest inspection point. Change to mileage rate is effective when the IRS changes their standard mileage rate.

Services requested and not covered by the above fees will be assessed the applicable hourly rate.

Official Commercial inspections are available upon request and fees will be negotiated on a case by case basis.
