

Guidelines for EU Certificate for Animal By-products for Technical Use

Part I. Details of Dispatched Consignment

- I.1 Enter full name, address, and telephone number of entity in the US exporting the product
- I.2 Enter serial number from FSIS Form 9060-5
- I.2.a Leave Blank
- I.3 Enter “FSIS”
- I.4 Enter FSIS District Office
- I.5 Enter full name, address, and telephone number of entity receiving the product in the EU
- I.6 Leave Blank
- I.7 If U.S., enter “US” and “US-0”. If from another country, enter appropriate code from attached source:
http://www.iso.org/iso/country_codes/iso_3166_code_lists/english_country_names_and_code_elements.htm.
- I.8 Mark through
- I.9 Enter destination of EU country name and ISO code
[Austria **AT**; Belgium **BE**; Bulgaria **BG**; Cyprus **CY**; Czech Republic **CZ**; Denmark **DK**; Estonia **EE**; Finland **FI**; France **FR**; Germany **DE**; Greece **GR**; Hungary **HU**; Ireland **IE**; Italy **IT**; Latvia **LV**; Lithuania **LT**; Luxembourg **LU**; Malta **MT**; Netherlands **NL**; Poland **PL**; Portugal **PT**; Romania **RO**; Slovakia **SK**, Slovenia **SL**, Spain **ES**; Sweden **SE**; and the United Kingdom/Northern Ireland **GB**]
- I.10 Leave Blank
- I.11 Enter Establishment name, address, and Est. No. of processing establishment
- I.12 Leave Blank
- I.13 Enter place of loading
- I.14 Enter date of shipment departure – should not precede the date in the signature block of the certificate.
- I.15 Complete as appropriate: Mark through “railway wagon, and road vehicle and other.” Indicate “Aeroplane” or “Ship” as appropriate, and provide ship name or airline flight number/s
- I.16 Enter Boarder Inspection Post (BIP) in the EU, point of first arrival
- I.17 Enter “NA”

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- I.18 Indicate animal species and description of product as labeled
- I.19 Enter the four digit “CN heading” code for the product being exported. The CN code is listed in the right-hand column in EU Directive 2002/349/EC of April 26, 2002, beginning on page L 121/9, Under Heading I.2 entitled, Products of animal origin. The CN code is the [Commodity Code or HS Code](#).
- I.20 Net Weight (Kg)
- I.21 Check appropriate box
- I.22 Enter No. of pieces or packages
- I.23 Enter container or seal number, only where applicable
- I.24 e.g. cans, cardboard, plastic, etc
- I.25 Check box “Technical Use”
- I.26 If transiting through the EU, enter destination country. Otherwise leave blank.
- I.27 If transiting through the EU leave blank. Otherwise check box.
- I.28 Enter information as appropriate
 - Complete with scientific name, such as: bovine; ovine; caprine; domestic equine; domestic porcine, etc.
 - Nature of commodity, complete as appropriate
 - Treatment type: Indicate storage life (MM/DD/YYYY)
 - Abattoir: Slaughter Est. No.
 - Manufacturing Est. No.
 - Cold Store Est. No.
 - Number of packages
 - Total Net weight in metric
- II.a Certificate No. from I.2
- II.b Mark through

II.1.3 Mark through entire 3rd section to the end of Section II.1.3 - beginning with [(a) captured and killed in the wild....

Mark through II.2, II.2.1 and II.2.2
