I hereby notify the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) of the use of statements of nutritional support in the labeling of DLPA, a dietary supplement. Source Naturals[®] is the manufacturer of DLPA.

Statements being made in the labeling of DLPA:

(1) Researchers believe that D-phenylalanine (DPA) inhibits the action of an enzyme that breaks down endorphins and enkephalins. These are proteins which bind to opiate receptor sites in the brain, thereby influencing the perception of minor discomfort associated with normal phsiological processes. By obstructing the action of this enzyme, DPA may extend the life of endorphinsand enkephalins and their positive influence on comfort levels.
