Dear FDA:

I am writing about your "Draft Guidance for Industry: Voluntary Labelling Indicating Whether Foods Have or Have Not Been Developed Using Bioengineering."

I am entirely against genetically-engineered foods. Therefore, add my vote to the 81% of Americans who want GE foods LABELLED so that we can refuse to buy them, and so that restaurants serving us can refuse to buy these foods also.

If you refuse to do so, you will lose all credibility, and we will have to elect other controlling institutions into place.

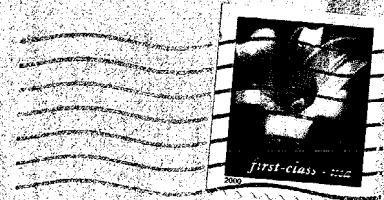
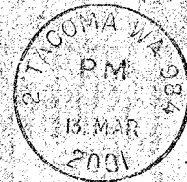
