You will be aware that animals who are too sick even to stand, pose a health threat and should not be allowed to enter the human food chain. Furthermore, it is impossible to move downed animals humanely, and they are typically pushed with tractors or dragged with chains - in humane processes which cause injuries ranging from bruises and abrasions, to broken bones and torn ligaments. You also know that downed animals comprise a very small percentage of animals slaughtered, and prohibiting their marketing will cause no undue economic hardships.

In view of this, I humbly request you to please grant petition 98P-0151/CP1 to prohibit the slaughter of downed animals.
