WATER PUMPS REMOVED FROM PINE RIDGE CAMPGROUND

Harrisburg, IL, July 22, 2008 – Acting District Ranger Tim Pohlman of the Hidden Springs

Ranger District of the Shawnee National Forest announced today he has ordered the water pumps

removed from the Pine Ridge Campground at Pounds Hollow. Water is trucked in and stored in

an underground tank. Test results on water samples from the campground revealed unacceptable

water quality. Campers in the area can get clean water from the picnic/beach area at Pounds

Hollow, which is connected to a municipal water system. "We are exploring options to resolve

the water quality issue in the campground," stated Pohlman, "either through repairing the tank or
