URS Aviation has recently been selected to provide consulting services for the taxiway rehabilitation. Construction is scheduled to begin Summer of 2008.

A project Open House is scheduled to provide an overview of the project and the proposed construction phasing plan.

**PROJECT OVERVIEW**

The Rehabilitation of Taxiway Bravo consists of a rehabilitative overlay of the taxiway pavement, associated utility improvements, reconstruction of several connecting taxiways at the Southwest Airpark, and construction of paved shoulders on Runway 13R/31L.

The engineering design for this work is 50% complete and the Airport has prepared a proposed

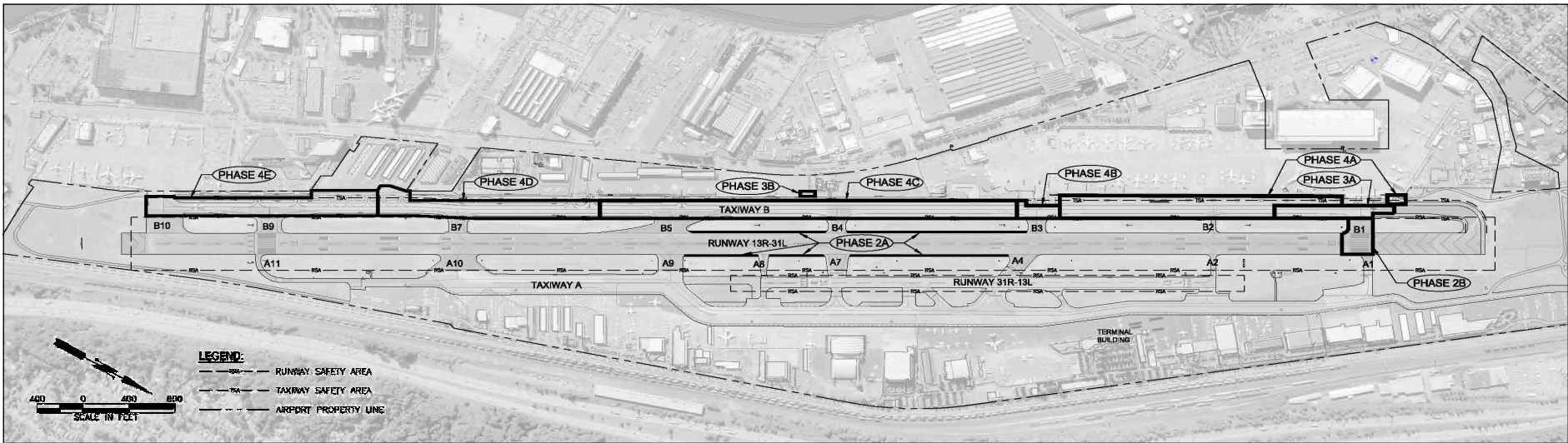
over the course of four weekends in the Summer of 2008. Currently, the phasing plan anticipates weekend closures from 9:00 am Saturday morning to 4:00 am Monday morning.

The remainder of the project will be the rehabilitation of the Bravo Taxiway. This work will be phased to allow all tenants access to an active portion of the Bravo Taxiway.

**Construction Phasing**

The table below provides the proposed draft construction phasing. Once all tenant and user feedback is compiled, a final construction phasing plan and associated project schedule will be prepared.



construction phasing plan that is intended to minimize impacts to Airport operations.

The project is principally directed at rehabilitation of the Bravo Taxiway. However, increasing incidents of Foreign Object Debris (FOD) on Runway 13R/31L was noted during a recent FAA certification inspection. To address this issue, the FAA has offered to fund the construction of paved shoulders along the center portion of the runway. This activity will require closure of Runway 13R/31L
