CROP REPORT FOR WEEK ENDING APRIL 13

Corn planting is underway in scattered fields around the state, according to the Indiana Agricultural Statistics Service. Most of theplanting has occurred in the southern regions of the state. Colder than normal temperatures slowed the drying process and may have damage budding fruit trees.

CROP PROGRESS

This

WINTER WHEAT

Thirteen percent of the wheat acreage is **jointed**, compared to 3 percent last year **a**d the 5-year average of 9 percent. Winter wheat**condition** is rated 66 percent good to excellent, compared to only 11 percent rated good at this time last year. Wheat condition ratings during the next few weeks will indicate whether or not the crop was damaged by the sub-freezing temperatures experienced during the past week.

SEED BED PREPARATION

Farmers continued to apply fertilizer and herbicides as the weather allowed. Soil conditions are still too wet in many areas to support heavy machinery. Most of the fieldword has taken place in lighter soils.

OTHER CROPS

Availability of hay and roughage supplies was rated percent surplus, 40 percent adequate, 44 percent shor and 15 percent very short. Pasture condition was rated 5 percent excellent, 46 percent good, 35 percent fair, 0 percent poor and 4 percent verypoor. The return of colder temperatures has slowed pasture growth.

DAYS SUITABLE and SOIL MOISTURE

For the week ending Friday, 3.5 days were rated suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture was rated 3 percent short, 68 percent adequate and 29 percent surplus Subsoil moisture was rated 2 percent short, 69 percent adequate and 29 percent surplus.
