- 1) Textiles accepted: reusable clothing, fabric, curtains, linens, bedding (no mattresses), area rugs, stuffed animals, boots & shoes.
- 2) Household Batteries accepted: button batteries, A, AA, AAA, C, D, and 9-Volt batteries. No vehicle or marine batteries.
- 3) **Scrap Metal accepted:** items made exclusively or primarily of metal including: chain link and wire fencing, lawn furniture, aluminum window frames, screen doors, household items, plumbing parts, piping (no insulation), siding, bicycles, auto parts, grills, gutters, wire, lawnmowers (must empty the mower of all fluids gasoline, oil and remove batteries).
- 4) Appliances: limit three appliances per trip. Household appliances from residents only. No commercial or industrial appliances.
- 5) Clean Wood accepted: branches over 4 inches in diameter, stumps (no dirt), pallets, cedar shingles (no tar paper), lath (no plaster), untreated and unpainted decking, fencing, plywood, and construction lumber. Nails and staples in the wood are ok. No painted, stained or treated wood. Length limit of 8 feet. Clean wood must be separated from garbage for recycling.
- 6) **Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Daily Limits:** 30 gallons per customer of full or partially full containers (container size must be 5 gallons or less), 10 fluorescent tubes, and 5 automotive batteries. The HHW service at Factoria is open Tuesday-Sunday from 9 am to 5 pm.
- 7) Yard Waste accepted: leaves, grass clippings, weeds, brush, prunings, and branches less than 4 inches in diameter and under 8 feet in length. Must be separated from garbage for recycling. No dirt, sod, stumps, or plastic.
