

## TOWN OF HOLLAND RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING GUIDE:

### **Newspapers**

### **Junk Mail**

All parts of your newspaper. All magazine, catalogs, telephone books, paperback books, writing paper, residential correspondence.

(Place loosely or in a paper bag or in your recycling bin. Include only clean products. **DO NOT PUT IN PLASTIC BAGS OR TIE IN BUNDLES.**)

### **Corrugated Cardboard,Boxboard.**

All brown corrugated ,all brown bags, Box board (shoe boxes), cereal and gift boxes, clean pizza boxes. ( Tape and staples do not have to be removed. Flatten and bundle in 3' x 3' sections. **ONLY CLEAN MATERIAL.**)

**Glass Bottles** All clear, green and brown glass Food and Beverage containers.

( Remove lids and caps. Rinse containers. Place metal lids in recycling bin, throw plastic lids away. **DO NOT PLACE IN PLASTIC BAGS.**)

**Metal Containers** All metal food and beverage containers. Aluminum food trays.

( Rinse containers. Labels do not have to be removed. **DO NOT PLACE IN PLASTIC BAGS.**)

**Plastics** Plastic food, soap, milk, windshield Washer fluid, detergent and bleach with . #1 or #2 recycle logo, cosmetic bottles ,(hair care, lotions, etc),Small mouth containers With screw top.

(Rinse containers. Dispose of caps. No wide mouth containers, such as butter, yogurt, cottage cheese, fruit cups , pudding, ect....tubs. Flatten if possible. Labels do not have to be removed. **DO NOT PLACE IN PLASTIC BAGS**)

### **NON-RECYCLABLES (PLACE IN TRASH)**

**NAPKINS, TISSUE PAPER, PAPER TOWELS, WRAPPING PAPER OR SOILED PAPER.**

**COATED BOXES, SOILED OR OIL SOAKED BOXES. CARDBOARD LINED WITH FOAM OR LAMINATED MATERIAL. NO WAX COATED BOXES. NO FAST-FOOD CONTAINERS.**

**CERAMIC BOTTLES AND OTHER CERAMIC ITEMS, FLOWER POTS, CRYSTAL , LIGHT BULBS, MIRROR AND WINDOW GLASS, HEAT RESISTANT OVENWARE, HYPODERMIC SYRINGES, EYEGLASSES AND DRINKING GLASSES.**

**PAINT , GASOLINE OR OIL CONTAINERS, AEROSOL CANS AND AUTOMOTIVE PARTS, PIPES, GUTTERS AND OTHER LARGE ITEMS. NO BATTERIES OR SCRAP METAL.**

**MOTOR OIL CONTAINERS, ANTIFREEZE CONTAINERS, TOYS, FURNITURE, PLATES, PLASTIC BAGS , TABLEWARE, PRESCRIPTION BOTTLES, PLEXIGLASS , FAST FOOD CONTAINERS, STYROFOAM, MICROWAVE CONTAINERS, TUPPERWARE AND PLASTIC PIPING. NO PLASTIC BAGS.**

**RECYCLING:**

Place all recyclable materials inside the bins provided by the town. All recyclables can be put out weekly on the same day as trash pickup. Glass , metal cans and plastic, paper and cardboard can all be placed together in the same recycling bin. Please place the recycling bin away from garbage so the driver can see it.

**GARBAGE:**

the equivalent of 4 bags or cans of normal household solid waste will be collected weekly. All waste must be containerized and the weight limit per bag or container is 60 pounds per bag or container.

**FOR COLLECTION:**

Place garbage and recyclables at the roadside, within 5 feet of the road, by 5 am. On the day of your trash pickup. If you have a ditch in front of your property, place garbage and recyclables between the road and the ditch.

**ONE LARGE ITEM WILL BE PICKED UP ON A WEEKLY BASIS THROUGHOUT THE YEAR. THIS ELIMINATES THE SPRING AND FALL LARGE TRASH PICK UP.** A large item is any refuse that cannot be placed in cans or bags easily. **ONLY ONE LARGE ITEM WILL BE PICKED UP EACH WEEK AT THE ROADSIDE.** Large items will be collected on the same day as regular service and placed in the compactor truck. These items shall include, but are not limited to , a piece of furniture, a mattress or box spring , 1 roll of carpet (rolled and tied in 4 foot lengths), a tub, toilet, or a wooden door. Weight limit is 60 pounds per item.

**ITEMS NOT INCLUDED IN THE WEEKLY COLLECTION:**

Tires , white goods, such as washers, dryers, dishwashers, water heaters , ranges, refrigerators , or freezers, pesticides, oils, solvents, flammable liquids explosives, animal carcasses, fecal matter, industrial waste, yard waste, construction and demolition debris, other regulated hazardous wastes or building materials left by a contractor. **IF YOU HIRE A CONTRACTOR FOR REMODELING JOBS, THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE REMOVAL OF DEBRIS.** Hazardous waste, along with propane tanks, batteries and gas tanks, can be taken to a collection site sponsored by Erie County.

**HOLIDAY SCHEDULE:**

NEW YEAR'S DAY, MEMORIAL DAY, INDEPENDENCE DAY, LABOR DAY, THANKSGIVING AND CHRISTMAS.

If your collection day is on or follows any of these holidays during the week, then your collection day will be one day sooner.

**WHITE GOODS:**

The town will pick up washers, dryers, ranges, water heaters, dishwashers. Refrigerators and freezers during the months of April through October on Mondays. There will be a prepaid \$15.00 charge for the removal of Freon in refrigerators and freezers. Call 537-9443 ext. 2 to schedule an appliance pickup.

**PASSENGER TIRES:**

2 per household , no rims. Batteries and propane tanks can be taken to the Town Highway Garage on Edgewood Drive during the months of April through October.

**RECYCLING BINS:**

Recycling bins are available if you have built a new home. Call the Town Hall at 537-9443 ext. 3 for information.
